EXAM PATTERN

- ◆ MECTA JEE MOCK TEST-2014 is the Computer Based online Test.
- ◆ This examination is common to 12th Science students.
- ◆ The syllabus for test shall be equivalent to JEE(main).
- ◆ The duration of exam is 3hrs.
- ◆ Each question is allotted 4 marks for the correct answer.
- ◆ 1 mark will be deducted for incorrect answer.
- ◆ Use of calculators/mobiles not permitted.
- ◆ Result of the examination will be displayed on the same day.
- ◆ **Test Centers** : MECTA JEE MOCK TEST-2014 will be held in engineering colleges in Maharashtra.
- ◆ **Registration fee** : Registration fees for examination is Rs 600/- (for 3 examination).
- ◆ Fees can be paid through online banking or by submitting the DD of Rs 600/- in favor of "MAHARASHTRA ENGINEERING COLLEGE TEACHER ASSOCIATION" Payble at NASHIK.

REGISTRATION

- ◆ The application form will be available only online on the website <http://www.mecta.in>
- ◆ Registration Process: REGISTER -> PAY -> APPEAR
- ◆ Registration link will be displayed on MECTA website.
- ◆ Candidate will provide personal details on the registration page (name, email, mobile, address etc) and register.
- ◆ After successful registration, candidate will be able to logon to the application.
- ◆ After login candidate will see a list of scheduled tests

PAYMENT

- ◆ Student will have "Pay Online"/"Pay by DD" buttons.
- ◆ In case of online payment, candidate is redirected to payment gateway and upon successful payment; state in scheduled test is updated to "Payment Received".
- ◆ In case of offline payment, candidate enters DD details and sends the DD to specified address. After verifying the DD, MECTA will update candidate payment status as "Payment Received"
- ◆ After successful payment candidates are assigned test centers, seat numbers and other test details.
- ◆ Candidates will appear for the test
- ◆ Results will be declared on the website.
